Let me first of all thank you for your leadership of the Bexar County Democratic Party. It is my understanding that the party will be considering passing a resolution to boycott Bill Miller BBQ. I think it is a huge mistake for the party to do so and I strongly urge you and the local members of the party to not boycott Bill Miller BBQ. A company should be judged by the services and products they provide and how they give back to the community, as well as how they treat their employees. Bill Miller has a stellar reputation: they give back to the community, treat their employees well and provide quality products and services to the community.

Bill Miller is a local company and has continually supported our community in their 66 years of service. They employ 5,200 employees in San Antonio and surrounding areas and have always paid above minimum wage. Employee tenure runs deep within the company with employees having 20, 30, and 40+ years of service.

Bill Miller supports education and is dedicated to giving back to our community. They donated 9 acres of land west of downtown to UTSA, during a time where there were no 4 year university available for south & west side students. They have provided over \$3,500,000 in tuition reimbursement since 1995, in addition to 42 - \$5,000 scholarships in the last 5 years. They also fund two "Student of the Month" non-employee scholarships to local high school students. Bill Miller stepped up in a time of need for SAISD's Mama Patrol, donating \$350,000 to fully fund the program for the year. They have also funded a \$100,000 scholarship to a female DACA student at Texas A&M-Kingsville. Bill Miller donates annually to local livestock shows (this year over \$100,000) which fund scholarships for area students. Bill Miller provided funding for the UIW Ila Faye Miller School of Nursing and is funding an endowment scholarship at Texas A&M-San Antonio and at Texas Tech.

Bill Miller continues to support our community in other ways. They were a major sponsor for the Walk to End Alzheimer's last year and will be a major sponsor for the San Antonio Area Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure this year. Bill Miller has also partnered with the South Texas Blood and Tissue Center for the past two years. To date, Bill Miller has fully funded the construction of 16 Habitat for Humanity homes in San Antonio. Bill Miller's donation committee supports community organizations by giving food, money and gift cards on a monthly basis.
